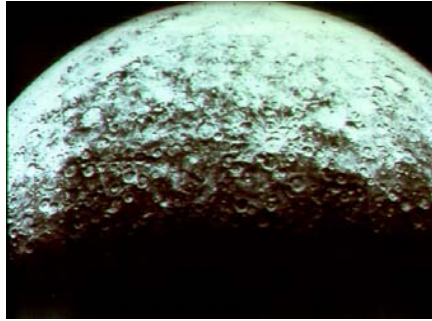


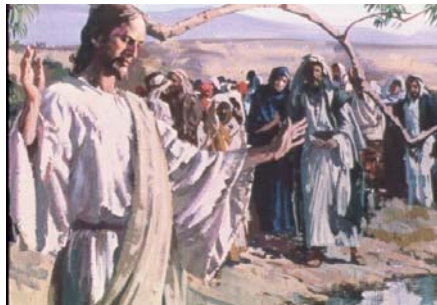
The Bottomless Pit

Greek: ἄβυσσος (with no bottom, bottomless)



And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness *was* upon the face of the deep. Gen 1:2

A Desolate Empty
Place



And Jesus asked him, saying, **What is thy name?** And he said, Legion: because many devils were entered into him. 31 And they besought him that he would not command them to go out into the deep. 32 And there was there an herd of many swine feeding on the mountain: and they besought him that he would suffer them to enter into them. And he suffered them. Luke 8:30-32

For demons, the deep is a place where they can not inhabit humans or animals. They can't rest unless they have someone or something to work on or harass.

When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest; Luke 11:24



And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. 2 And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years, 3 And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season. Rev 20:1-3

From the above definitions. The abyss or bottomless pit will be a desolate place where Satan is unable to possess people and will not find "rest" because he will be unemployed
