Message: The kingdom is at hand, the time is fulfilled. Mark 1:14,15; Matt 10:7	1	Message: The time is fulfilled. Christ is returning.
Message based on time: 490 Years Daniel 9:24-27	2	Message based on time: 2300 years Daniel 8:14; Rev 14:6,7.
Missed part of passage: Christ's death in Dan 9:27	3	Missed part of passage: Missed 3 rd angel's message in Rev 14:9-12.
Influenced by prevailing views: Messiah would set up earthly kingdom.	4	Influenced by prevailing views: The sanctuary was the earth.
Received warnings about the event: Jesus' warnings in Matt 16:21	5	Received warnings about the event: William Foy's vision of 12 hours in 1842.
